Contemporary Issues in Animated Films (Disney/Pixar Theory) for Teens. June 12- 16, 10am-2:30pm. Watch 10 Disney/Pixar films in chronological order in an attempt to breakdown the Pixar Theory which believes that all Disney/Pixar films are related and build off one another in their own sort of universe (based on ours).

e-Textiles Camp for ages 8+ June 19-23, 10am-1pm. **Spaces:** 18 Review electronic circuit basics, then complete challenges to sew your own light-up electronics into fabric using conductive thread. *This is not a sewing class. Students should already have basic sewing skills.*

Electronics & Robotics Camp for ages 8+ July 17-19, 10am-1pm. **Spaces:** 18 Learn basic robotic, electrical, and programming concepts. Make motors whirl, lights blink, and buzzers ring. Draw a maze and program a robot to spin and turn its way through it.

Piper Computer Hardware Maker Camp for ages 9—18. July 31—August 4, 10:30am-1:30pm. **Spaces:** 18 Campers will work in teams to assemble Piper computers themselves, advance through a Raspberry Pi Edition of Minecraft Story, and learn physical engineering and electronics in the process.

Comic Book Creator Camp: Bricks, Camera, ...Comic Action! For ages 8+ August 7-11, 10 am-1:30pm **Spaces:** 16 *Ask about fees**.* Led by Bricks 4 Kidz. Campers create digital comic books using stop action photos and scenes that they engineer with LEGOs.
