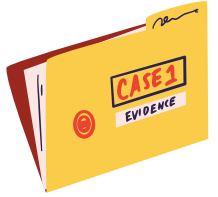
Forensics Camp: The Cookie Mystery

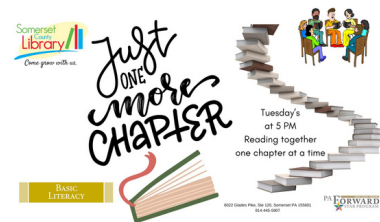


Book Clubs

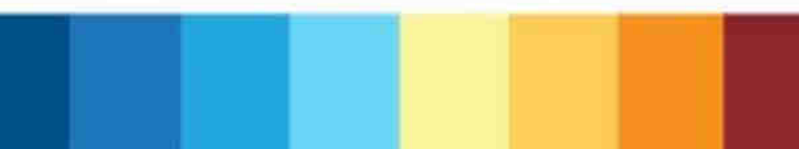

Why is your donation important?

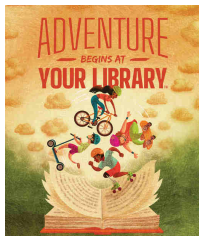
